 - 46% Private, 35% Public, 35% Federal/Other, 5% PhD

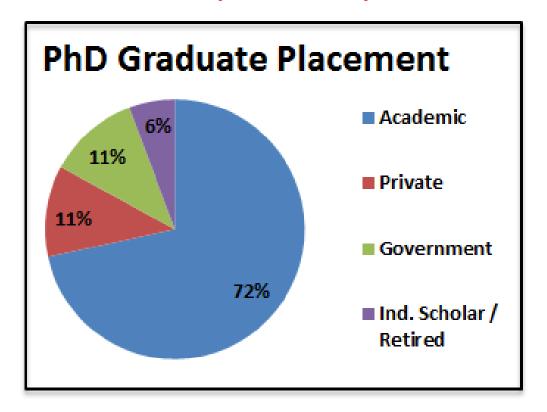






Graduate Programs - PhD

ATGS 2017 - Questions

- What information do you track?
 - Running list of graduates and their current employment position at the Master's and Ph.D. level
- How do you obtain this information?
 - LinkedIn (consistently), Facebook (some time), e-mail (occasionally). Proactive before they start, during, and after
 - When an alumnus/a changes jobs, notification via email by LinkedIn, and update in spreadsheet
 - Alumni are also found by looking at our alumni's friends/connections on LinkedIn
 - Faculty play a role as well. When alumni start a new job, especially PhDs, they inform faculty, who informs office
- When do you collect it? How do you update it?
 - Late April and early May every year by checking the graduation spreadsheet against information on LinkedIn and Google searches







- How much time does it take and who in the department does it?
 - It generally takes a month or so for part-time student worker (about 40 hours) to update the spreadsheet
 - Throughout the year, a few additional hours a month to peruse LinkedIn, Facebook, Google searches, etc.
 - Graduate Staff Advisor (Allison Glass-Smith) and student worker
- How much does it cost?
 - Tools are free to use. Personnel costs, of course
- What do you do with the information you collect, i.e., how do you engage alumni?
 - Annual Alumni Reunion and Student Celebration: alumni awards, job panels with alumni, networking opportunities
 - Newsletters and business card directory
 - Reception at the annual AAG Meeting
 - Social media
